Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, more commonly known as the Feast of Corpus Christi. Through the Eucharist Jesus gives us the strength we need to journey through our life to heaven.

In our readings for this Sunday Moses reminds the people, in the book of Deuteronomy, of how God brought them out of the land of Egypt through forty years in the desert and how he fed them with manna.
