The readings for this Sunday work together to teach us about the real obligations of the law, which include gently correcting one another so that our communities may be in harmony.

In the reading from Ezekiel, the Lord tells Ezekiel that he will be held responsible for the death of the wicked one if he does not speak out to dissuade him from his way. In the letter to the Romans, St. Paul writes that the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. St. Paul explains how we must do this and do all things with love.

In this Sunday's gospel Jesus gives instructions for correcting another, his authority to bind and loose, and promises where two or three are gathered in His name, there He is in their midst. Jesus promises to remain with us always.
