The vast amount of cemetery work has been accomplished over the past thirty some years. It is just time for new parishioners to take over the different roles involved.

FROM OUR PARISH NURSE ...

Cholesterol-lowering statin drugs help prevent heart attacks and strokes in people at "intermediate risk" for cardiovascular disease, a major study in the *New England Journal of Medicine* has confirmed. The study involved 12,705 people from 21 countries. None had cardiovascular disease, but all were at intermediate risk because of factors such as obesity or smoking. Over the course of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ years, people taking statins were 24% less likely to have a heart attack or stroke than those taking a placebo. That worked out to about one less event per 100 people. Statin users had a lower rate of discontinuation due to adverse effects than those taking the placebo.
